# ***TYPES OF SERVICE***

Before, during or after the completion of an MYP related unit, teachers will work with students on brainstorming ideas for Service as Action that may result from the unit of study. Students may choose to engage in one or more of the following types of service learning:

<b><i>Service</i></b>	<b><i>Definition</i></b>
Direct	interactions that involve people, the environment or animals
Indirect	actions that do not involve direct interaction with the recipients of service but can be verified and/or measured as having beneficial impacts on the community or environment
Advocacy	speak on behalf of a cause or concern to promote actions in others on an issue of public interest
Actionable Research	collect information through varied sources, analyze data and report publicly on a topic of importance to influence policy or practice

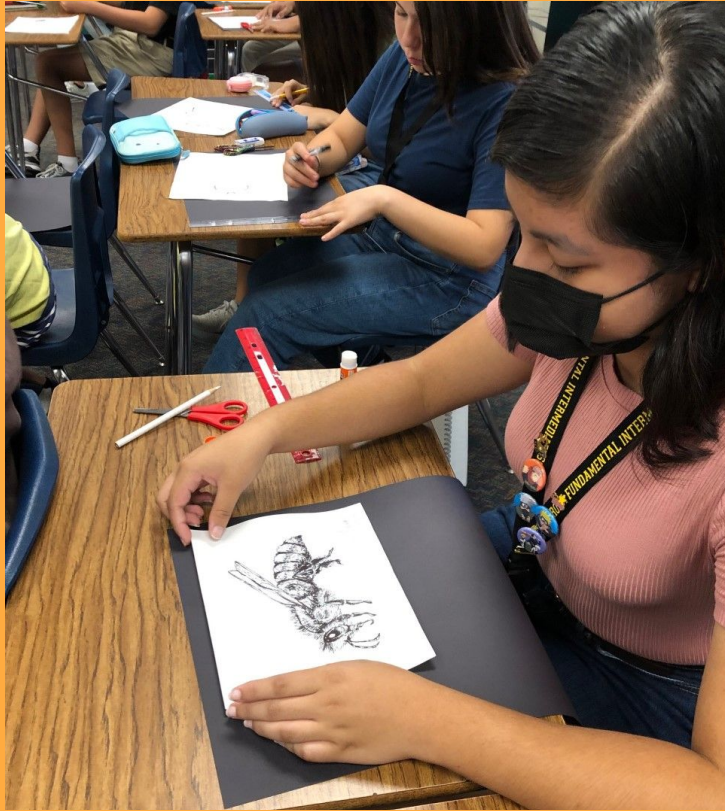

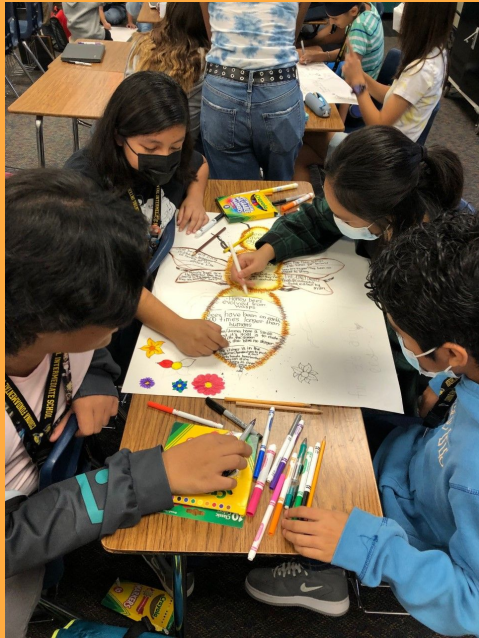
**Advocacy**

3. **Direct/Advocacy:** create bee catchers to give to each classroom with a short PSA presentation.



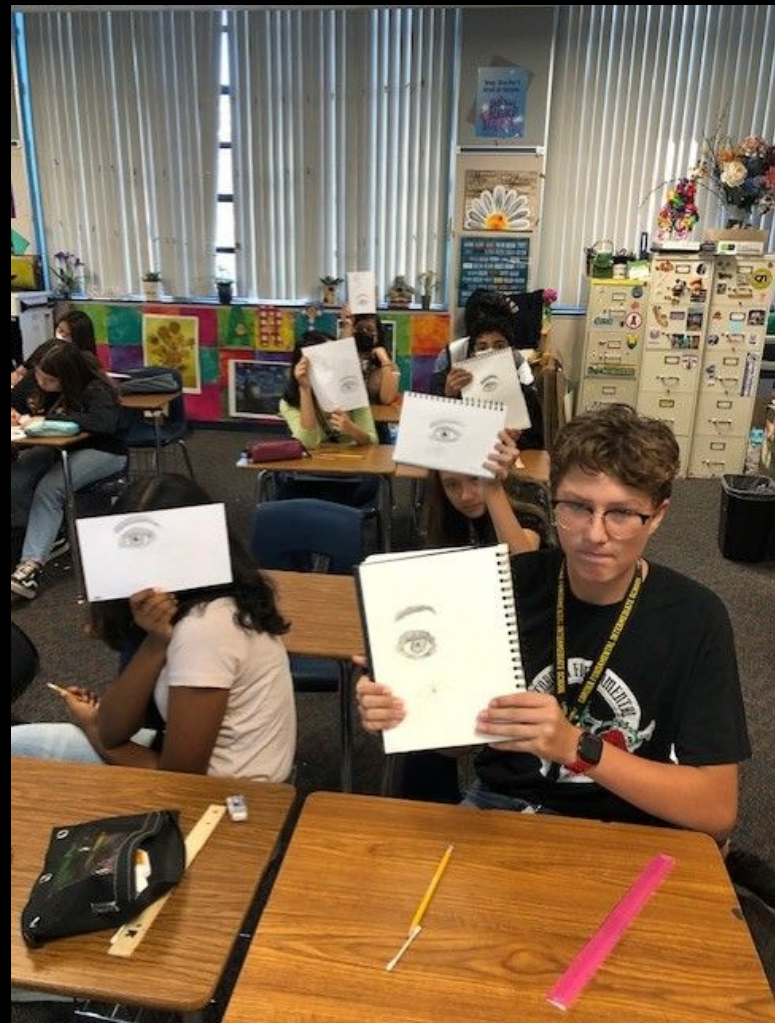
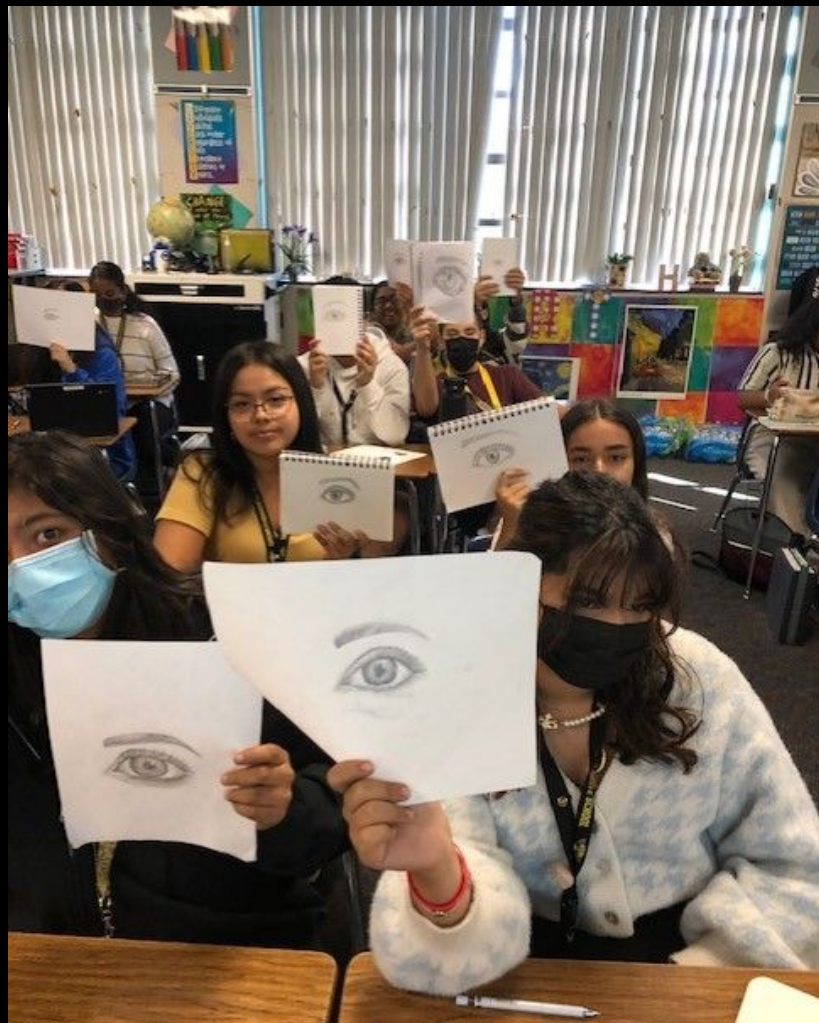
# Advocacy

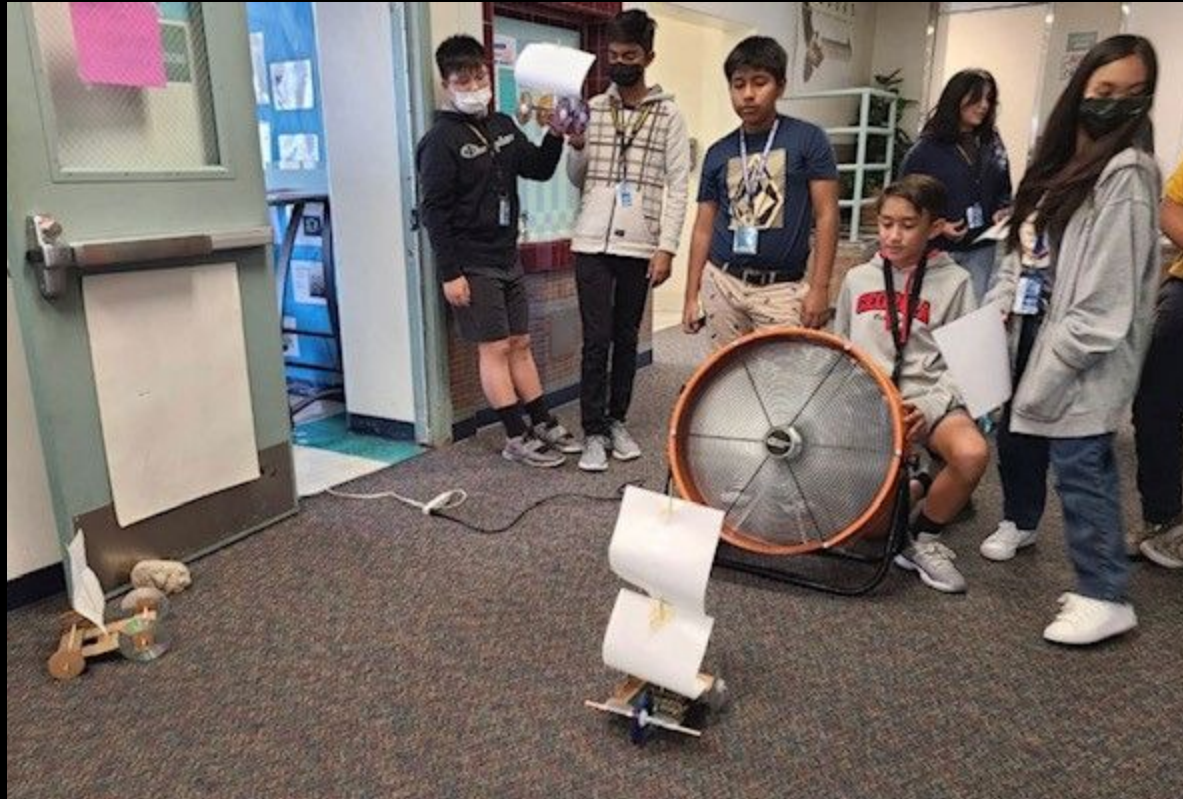
