

## Student Application Process

1. Procure an **Interest Application**. These will be available on our website at [www.cnusd.k12.ca.us/cfis](http://www.cnusd.k12.ca.us/cfis). They are also available in the school (C.F.I.S) office.
2. Complete the Interest Application indicating "IB" as your choice and submit by the indicated deadline to the school.
3. Academic readiness for the IBMYP will be the primary entrance criteria. The last grade report prior to the lottery must reflect all A's and/or B's in all classes, as well as all outstanding and/or satisfactory behavior marks. (Our office will pull those grade reports. No copies need be provided by the parent).

## IBMYP Philosophy

- **Breadth of Knowledge** is developed in language arts, Spanish, history, mathematics, science, fine arts, design, and physical education which are all full independent courses at C.F.I.S..
- **Interdisciplinary Study** to understand how the subjects relate to each other is emphasized.

- **Study Skills and Critical Analysis Skills** are developed in preparation for more rigorous programs.
- **Civic Responsibility** is developed through service opportunities.

### IBMYP Overview

International Baccalaureate (IB) is an internationally recognized program offered in more than 60 countries worldwide. Our IB Middle Years Program (IBMYP) consists of grades 7 and 8 on a year-round track system (Track A) at C.F.I.S.. The IBMYP then continues through grades 9 and 10 at Centennial High School. A primary objective is to prepare students for the IB Diploma Program available only in grades 11 and 12.

The IBMYP focuses on helping students to develop the knowledge, skills and attitudes necessary for success in the more rigorous high school programs and to help them meet the challenges of university level work. Authentic assessment with an international focus is stressed. This also prepares students for the state common core standards assessments.

The Global Contexts used in the MYP help students see the interrelated nature of knowledge and the relevance of academic subjects to their own lives. These six Global Contexts (identities and relationships, orientation in space and time, personal and cultural expression, scientific and technical innovation, globalization and sustainability, fairness and development) enable our students to face the challenges of the world today and to develop creative solutions and understanding.

Students perform supervised community service to foster a sense of individual competence, civic pride and personal work ethic.

- is academically successful and motivated to learn
- has strong reading comprehension and mathematics skills
- is willing to improve study habits
- is curious about many things and is open-minded
- is willing to attempt all assignments and projects
